- 1. WINTER LEAVE FOLIAGE FROM LAST YEAR TO DIE DOWN & CLEAN OFF IN THE SPRING
- 2. MARCH & APRIL A. WEED AND CLEAN OFF LAST YEARS GROWTH
- B. FERTILIZE WITH AT LEAST 10-10-10
- C. OSMOCOTE PLUS [3-4 MONTH] IS ANOTHER SLOW RELEASE FERTILIZER TO USE WHEN WANT TO REALLY PUSH PLANTS TO DO WELL
- 3. MAY A. MULCH WITH DOUBLE GROUND NATURAL [3" MINIMUM]
- B. MILORGANITE FERTILIZER AROUND PERIMETER GARDENS AND PLANTS ALSO FOR EARLY DEER CONTROL. SPREAD AGAIN WHEN SCAPES START OR ANYTIME SEE DEER INTEREST. THIS IS ALSO A SLOW RELEASE IRON FERTILIZER THAN DOESN'T BURN FOLIAGE
- C. OSMOCOTE [5-6 MONTH] FORMULA IS ANOTHER SLOW RELEASE FERTILIZER TO USE WHEN PLANTS BEING PUSHED TO GROW
- **4. JUNE** A. OBSERVE FOR EARLY SCAPES AND START TO ENJOY YOUR EFFORTS. REAPPLY MILORGANITE AND ADD SPRAY WITH "REPELS ALL" IF NEEDED. NURSING DOES ARE RELENTLESS!!
- B. FILL SOCKS WITH MILORGANITE AND PLACE ON STAKES RANDOMLY ALONG BORDER OF DAYLILY BEDS
- B. WATER, WATER, !!! PLANTS NEED MINIMUM OFF 1" RAIN PER WEEK FROM MOTHER NATURE OR US. [PLANTS DON'T DIE BUT BLOOM SIZE DECREASES AND TEND DROP BUDS AS THEY GET DRIER.
- C. DEAD HEAD FOR VISUAL ENHANCEMENT & REMOVE RANDOM SEED PODS AS THEY TAKE NOURISHMENT FROM PLANTS
- **5. JULY & AUGUST** ENJOY YOUR GARDENS [REMEMBER TO WATER] B. MINIMUM OF 6 HOURS LIGHT- MORE IS BETTER- FULL SUN IS OK
- **6. SEPTEMBER** A. DIVIDE PLANTS AS CENTERS START DYING OUT AND BLOOM SIZE DECREASES. DIG AND CUT INTO 3-4 FAN SIZE OR TAKE 1\2 PLANT OFF AND LEAVE ORIGINAL
- 7. DON'T PLAN ON REBLOOM IN NORTHERN GARDENS. IT DEPENDS ON MOTHER NATURE AND GARDEN HUSBANDRY
- 8. **PLANNING A NEW BED?** A. PREPARE AREA BEFORE PURCHASE. RECOMMEND ENHANCING SOIL WITH PEAT. B. DAYLILIES TOLERATE A LOT OF CONDITIONS BUT DON'T LIKE BOGGY AREAS. C. PLANT 3 FEET APART AND SLIGHTLY DEEPER THAN SOIL LEVEL SEEN ON PLANTS [TEND TO HEAVE IN THE FIRST WINTER] D. BEST TO BUY IN BLOOM SO YOU KNOW WHAT YOU'RE GETTING!! E. SHOP 3-4 TIMES DURING BLOOM SEASON TO EXTEND BLOOM SEASON
